Listed as the 74th-ranked senior in 2003-04 according to *Blue Star Basketball* • McDonald's All-America nominee in 2003-04 • *Street & Smith's* honorable mention All-American in 2003 • Averaged 17 points per game, 2.8 assists per game and 1.7 steals per game in 2003-04 • Fourth on Lee's Summit career scoring list with 1,703 points • Started every game she played in all four years • Helped Lee's Summit to Missouri Final Four appearances in 2003 and 2004 • AAU All-American 16-U in 2003 • First team All-State selection by Missouri Coaches Association and Missouri Sports Writers in 2003 • Two-time All-Big 8 conference selection • First team All-District in Missouri Class 4A • Averaged over 14.9 points and 2.6 assists in her first three seasons • Hit 82 3-pointers and nabbed 161 steals in her first three years • Second team All-State in volleyball in 2003 • All-Area, All-District and All-Big 8 conference volleyball player in 2003 • Coached by Brian Bubalo • Also played for the Hoops Service and Mo Valley Eclipse AAU Teams, coached by Les Edison.

Italian customs that seemed strange to you: They are very affectionate

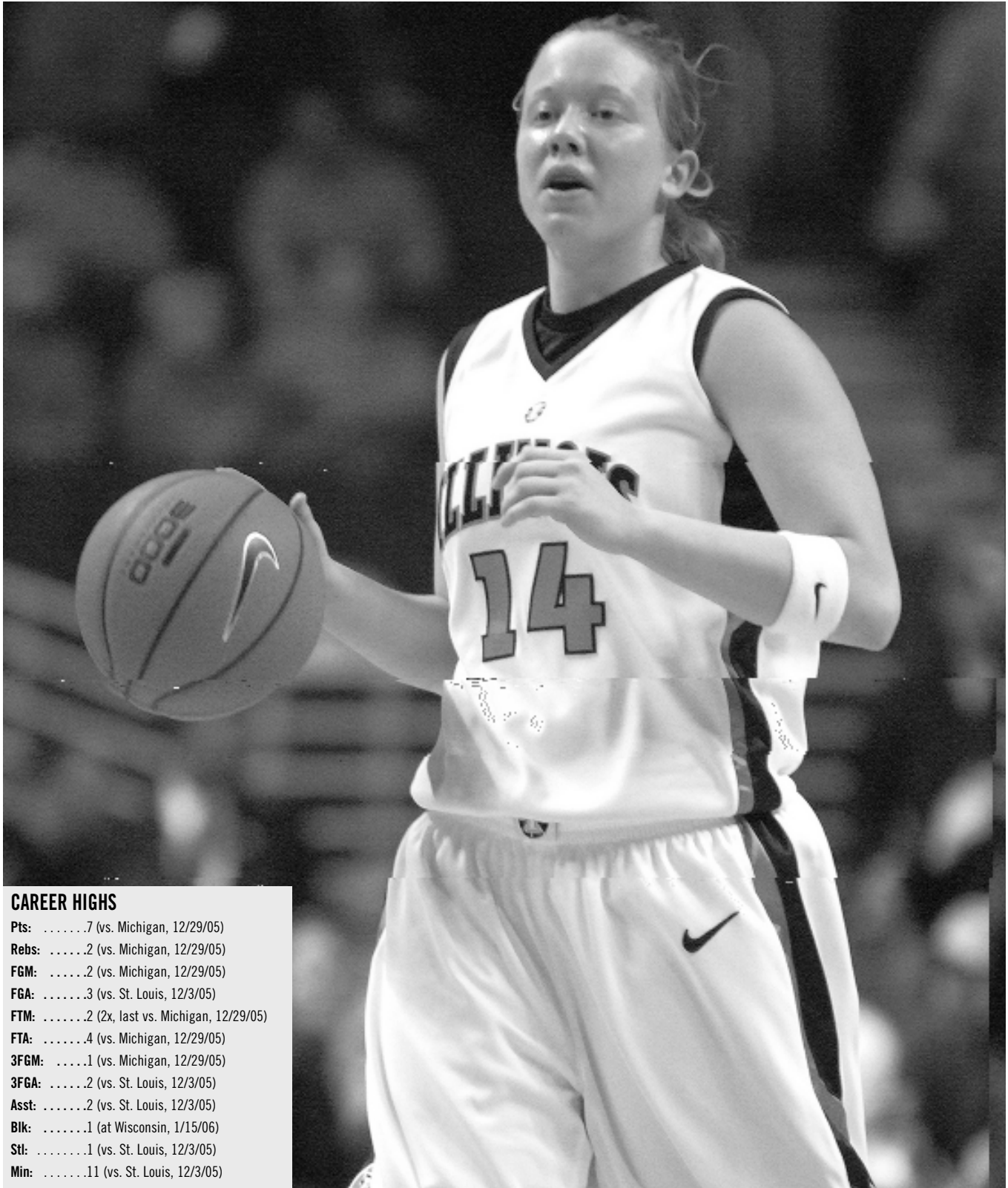
